Even the omnipresent channels of the mind will become an integral area of deliberations. CALL FOR ORAL AND POSTER PRESENTATIONS

- ▶ Oral and poster paper presentation sessions are scheduled during the Seminar.
- ▶ Original unpublished papers from UG students, PG scholars, Ph.D. scholars, academicians and researchers are invited for the presentation as per theme and Sub-themes.
- ▶ Received abstracts will be screened by the scientific committee for suitability with the theme and short-listed ones will be communicated on the committed date.
- ▶ One best paper award and one best poster award will be adjudicated for UG students, PG scholars, and Ph.D. scholars/ Academicians separately.

Guidelines for Abstract and Paper submission

- The paper should not have been presented or published before anywhere.
- Abstract should be submitted in MS Word document, Times New Roman fonts, 12 pts, 1.5 line space not exceeding 300 words.
- The abstract should be submitted in IMRaD format including - Title, Name(s) of the author(s) with designation, corresponding (presenting) Author, institute's name, communication details, Theme (under which the abstract is being submitted), Keywords (3-5).
- Full paper must be typed in English on MS Word with Times New Roman font (size 12) on A-4 sized paper, not exceeding 2500 to 3000 words. Referencing must be according to Vancouver style of referencing.
- Title should include case study/case report/experimental/ literary/ observational/survey etc.
- Shloka, may be typed in Google input tool Hindi or Sanskrit font, and give the complete references.
- Abstract and Paper should be sent by email to sukhayu.2023@mgug.ac.in
- Selected papers will be considered for oral or poster presentation.
- Registered Authors will be notified of abstract acceptance through official e-mail.
- The full article must be submitted on or before the last date.

Format for Oral & Poster Presentation

- ▶ For Oral presentation, the presenter will get six minutes (5 + 1) time.
- ▶ PPT should contain maximum 15 slides with Font size 24 - 28.

Format for Poster

- ▶ The recommended size for poster is 3 (width) x 4 (height) feet.
- ▶ Poster includes Title, Author and Co-author names with institutional affiliation, methods, results and conclusion.
- ▶ Text should be clear and to the point.
- ▶ Use of bullets, numbering and headlines make it easy to read
- ▶ All diagrams, pictures, tables and equations used in posters should be visible to read.
- ▶ E-mail and phone number should be placed on the upper right side of the poster.
- ▶ The templates for the abstract and the PPT is available on the website.


