Job Title: Lab Technician (Pathology) -----0 2 Posts

Job Requirement: Mahayogi Gorakhnath University, Gorakhpur invites applications for the position of **Lab Technician (Pathology)** to support diagnostic services, including specimen collection, laboratory testing, and accurate reporting to assist clinicians in disease diagnosis and treatment. The role demands professional knowledge in pathology lab procedures, attention to detail, and strict adherence to quality and safety standards.

Job Description: The following are the job roles and description of the duties:

- Collect and label patient samples (blood, urine, sputum, etc.) with proper aseptic techniques.
- Perform routine hematological, biochemical and microbiological tests as per standard protocols.
- Prepare reagents, stains and media required for testing.
- Operate and maintain laboratory instruments and diagnostic equipment.
- Record, analyze and maintain test results with accuracy and confidentiality.
- Ensure proper biomedical waste disposal as per guidelines.
- Coordinate with doctors, nursing staff and other departments for timely reporting.

Essential Qualification: Diploma or Bachelor's Degree in Medical Laboratory Technology (DMLT/BMLT) from a recognized institution. Proficiency in pathology lab procedures and equipment handling.

Desirable Qualification: Certification in quality control or hematology/microbiology specialization will be an added advantage.

Experience: Minimum 1 year of laboratory experience preferred. However, freshers may also apply.
